1. SHOW ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- *One owner per entry form~ Limit (3) entries per class except for the All-Around
- *Owner must be a current Active or Life Member of the NACA
- *All cattle must be entered by the registered owner
- *Photocopies of the **FRONT** of each animal's NACA registration certificate **Must** accompany entry form
- *Mature Cows 3 years of age and older, owner must provide proof of fertility in one of the following 4 ways.
 1. Calf at side
 2. Cow production summary
 3. Licensed Veterinarian statement that cow is bred
 4. Licensed Veterinarian Statement that the cow is capable of being bred (This will be checked when unloaded if not provided before)
- *Number brands or tattoos must be legible; clip number brands if necessary,
- **DO NOT clip holding brand**
- *All animals that are pending **must** have a registration number assigned in the NACA office no later than the deadline for entries, 4/12/10
- *A copy of each animal's papers must be presented upon arrival of the show,
- *You must present valid health papers before any animals are unloaded
- *The Texas Corriente Cattle Association reserves the right to cancel a class due to lack of participation and will contact each entry as soon as the decision has been made so the entry refund can be arranged.

2. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR LIVESTOCK ENTERED IN THE TCCA 2009 SHOW:

- **ASK YOUR VET FOR REQUIRED HEALTH REQUIREMENTS TO TRAVEL FROM YOUR AREA**
- visit the Texas Animal Health Commission website for information:

- contact the Texas Animal Health Commission on travel requirements within the State of Texas, or for entry requirements into the State of Texas, or have your local vet call: 1-800-550-8242
- all cattle and horses must have a valid Certificate of Veterinary Inspection, issued within the 30 days prior to the show
- cattle coming in from out-of-state: check your state's Brucella & TB status--you may be required to do testing for 1 or both to enter Texas!
- all horses are required to have a negative Coggins' test for EIA within the 6 months prior to the Show

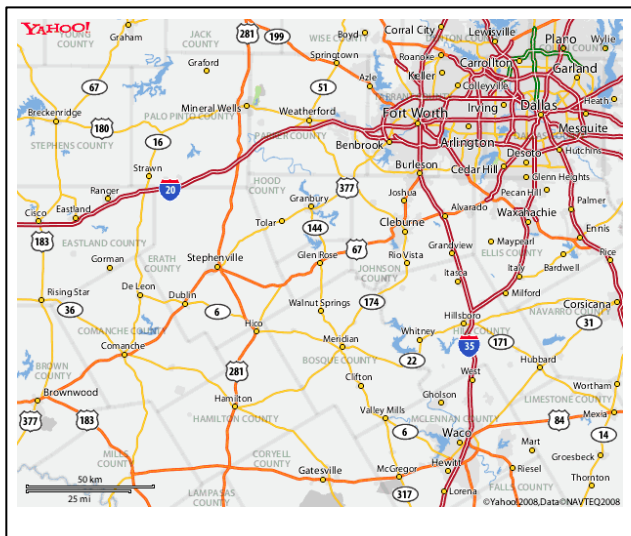

6. ROPINGS

A. Breeder's Saddle Roping: *entries accepted in Show Office during show*

- #12 Handicap, with #7 cap, triad system, roper must have current USTRC card to collect. (for more information contact roping committee)
 - Cowboy Classic saddles awarded to 1st place team, custom TCCA trophy arena jackets to 2nd place team
 - Entry fee of \$200.00 per Breeder, Draw a total of four partners, rope 3 head, progressive after one. Prizes only
 - Each Breeder must be in attendance at & exhibited cattle in the show to enter the roping
 - Ropers must qualify as NACA breeders: anyone who has registered cattle in their current membership name within the past two years and has requested to be on the NACA Breeders List.
 - If not roping for your ranch, you must submit your "designated roper" to Rules Committee. All designated roper entries will be reviewed upon entry deadline.
 - Your "designated roper" can be eligible under the following circumstances:
 - Spouse, Child or Parent: under handicap level of #7, Employee of over 6 months: capped at #5
 - Another qualifying breeder (capped at a #5) that is not entered more than one time in the roping
 - **NO ONE WILL ROPE FOR MORE THAN 2 RANCHES!**
 - Ropers will designate preferred end.
 - All decisions made by Rules Committee (Holt and Maben) will be final.
 - Three head roping
 - Allowable reasons for designating an alternate roper:
 - 1) wish to choose family member and/or persons designated above, 2) injury or illness, 3) inability
- In short, if you are a #6 or #7 breeder, you will be able to represent your ranch in the breeders roping. You WILL NOT be able to enter more than one time.***

B. MEMBERS ROPING:

- All ropers must have purchased 2010 TCCA membership for \$30.00 prior to entry in either of the membership ropings. 2010 TCCA memberships will make the roper eligible to enter all TCCA ropings to be held this year.

C. TCCA ROPING COMMITTEE:

The TCCA Roping Committee reserves the right to:

- reclassify any roper.
- hold entry fees and potential winnings when a TCCA membership or USTRC ranking is questioned, until status is clarified
- disqualify ropers for excessive foul language, abuse to animals or roping staff, or other undesirable behavior. If disqualified, entry fees and winnings are forfeited.
- determine all formats or types of ropings that will be held, as well as fees, payouts, how prizes are awarded, stock charges, and stock used.
- have total control and final say over any and all matters that may arise.

8. OTHER INFORMATION

The TCCA wants all cattle entered in our show to arrive in healthy, "well-cared-for" condition. Trailering cattle to shows is a natural stressor; the high temperature and high humidity common in Texas in late April should be taken into account, especially for cattle still carrying winter coat. Therefore, your cattle will likely need more feed and water than usual. Given the amount of media attention, numerous visitors, and potential buyers looking at our animals at our show, this is a golden opportunity for some very effective p.r. All of us need to work together to be mindful of the condition of our cattle, and keep them properly fed and watered. Anybody needing help with stock care at our show is welcome to contact the Show Manager or Show Secretary--we'll be glad to organize some assistance!
